THE WAY WE WORK

With decades of experience in shipbuilding, Sea Style Company has its registered office as well as main workshops in **Massafra-Taranto** and currently operates at three separate construction sites in Italy (in **Massa**, **Pisa** and **Taranto**), within historically structured industrial districts, organized between warehouses and yards, compartmentalized and functionalized to simultaneously carry out different phases of the production process of metal hulls and superstructures, all close to the seafront.

The availability of appropriately distinct spaces allows us to organize activities in such a way as to minimize contamination and pollution of materials, a fundamental aspect when working with precious metals such as steel and aluminum. The division of production steps also allows us to optimize resources and ensure the highest quality and precision in the processing of each single component, as required by the most rigorous international standards in the sector. All with the best guarantee of providing the most demanding market with boats ready in terms of solidity and safety.



Furthermore, Sea Style Company regularly carries out complex orders on behalf of third parties, at industrial sites owned by customers (c/o Fincantieri in **Manfalcone-Gorizia**, c/o Azimut Benetti in **Leghorn**, c/o Sanlorenzo in **La Spezia** and in **Marghera-Venice**) and is about to start the construction under a multi-decade state concession of another large Mediterranean hub for shipbuilding and refitting, called **Cantieri di Puglia**.



General plans relating to areas PRO-1 and PRO-2 (former Soico and Belleli Yards) of the Taranto Port Authority's master plan:


